

BlackBerry Connect Email Set Up Guide

With BlackBerry Connect, you can wirelessly access your corporate and personal email on your Nokia device. Email messages are automatically delivered and you can send, receive and reply to email directly from your device. This guide explains the two ways to get BlackBerry Connect on your Nokia device.

- **BlackBerry Enterprise Server** — Send and receive email from your company's corporate network if your company has a BlackBerry Enterprise Server installed. You can also look up email addresses from your company's electronic directory.
- **BlackBerry Internet Service** — Send and receive email from an Internet Service Provider (ISP) or other email accounts (POP3, IMAP4, SMTP).

You can set up and use BlackBerry Enterprise Server or BlackBerry Internet Service or you can set up and use both at the same time to get email from multiple accounts.

You will need to have BlackBerry Connect service to enable BlackBerry email.

1 Installing the BlackBerry client on the device

If your Nokia device does not already have BlackBerry Connect on it, you can download the installation file using your mobile device.

After turning on your device, follow the steps below:

1. From the Home screen of your Nokia device, select **Menu > Installat.** and open the E-mail installation application and read the application information.
2. Select **Options > Installable clients.**
3. Scroll down to **BlackBerry**, then select **Options > Install.**
4. Scroll to and select the correct version of the BlackBerry installation file for your device.
5. Fill in the requested information (location, name, mobile number, email address), accept the End User Software Agreement and click **Send.**
6. The file should begin to download automatically and download details will display on your device (fig. 1.1 and 1.2).

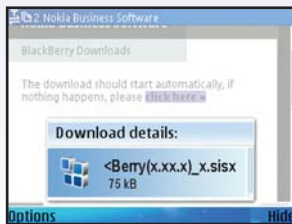

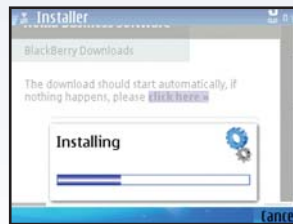

2 Installing the BlackBerry client on the device cont'd.

After the file has been downloaded to your device, begin the BlackBerry Connect installation:

1. Select **Yes** when asked if you want to install BlackBerry Connect.
2. Select **Continue** after you read the application information.
3. You will see an "Installation Complete" notice when BlackBerry Connect has finished installing on your device.
4. Select **Options > Exit** to close the browser.

After you have installed the BlackBerry file, enable BlackBerry Connect on your device:

1. Power on your device to connect to the mobile network (if not already on).
2. Select **Menu > Messaging > Options > Settings.**
3. Select **Email > BlackBerry.**
4. In the **General tab**, set BlackBerry service to **On.**
5. Press **Back** or select **Options > Exit** to exit settings.

You are ready to continue when both the GPRS () and BlackBerry () icons are visible on the device display.

3 Connecting with a BlackBerry Enterprise Server

The BlackBerry Enterprise Server automatically sends and receives email between your device and your corporate network email server. This option requires that the company have a BlackBerry Enterprise Server as part of its email system. To get started with a BlackBerry Enterprise Server:

1. Check with your IT department to ensure compatibility with your company's email server. If your company does not support BlackBerry Enterprise Server you can configure a personal BlackBerry email account using BlackBerry Internet Service.
2. Insert the Getting Started CD that came with your device into your CD drive. Click the **Install Software** tab and select **Install Nokia PC Suite AND BlackBerry Configuration for Nokia**. The wizards will help you:
 - Install Nokia PC Suite. (You must install Nokia PC Suite before you configure your device to work with BlackBerry Connect.)
 - Install BlackBerry Configuration for Nokia that helps you configure BlackBerry Connect on your device.
3. When prompted, connect your Nokia device to your computer using the data cable (preferred method). A list of connection modes will appear on the device screen; select **PC Suite**.
4. Launch the BlackBerry Configuration for Nokia desktop application.
5. Press **Connect** in the BlackBerry Configuration for Nokia to enable your device with BlackBerry email and calendar synchronization.

4 Connecting with BlackBerry Internet Service

Use BlackBerry Internet Service to automatically send and receive email for up to ten Internet Service Provider (ISP) or other email accounts such as POP3, SMTP or IMAP4.

To get started with BlackBerry Internet Service:

1. If you do not already have one, set up a compatible email account.
2. Contact your wireless service provider to activate BlackBerry Connect on your device. Your service provider will request the International Mobile Equipment Identity (IMEI) and Personal Identification Number (PIN) of your device. When BlackBerry Connect is installed on your device, you can find this information by selecting **Menu > Messages > Options > Settings > BlackBerry Service**. Then scroll to the BlackBerry Device tab where the codes are listed.
3. The next steps depend on your service provider. Check with your service provider for information about provisioning and setting up BlackBerry Internet Service.

Note: You will need your Internet email account name and password to integrate your ISP email account with BlackBerry Internet Service.
